WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

This fellowship provides college first-years and sophomores with:

- the opportunity to conduct policy-driven academic research
- knowledge about security studies
- guidance on navigating college
- data science skills
- information about policy and academic careers

WHAT TO EXPECT

Students will:

- participate in a three-day orientation in August 2023
- meet with faculty mentors during the 2023-2024 school year
- receive a **financial stipend** for their participation
- join academic research teams as **paid researchers** in Summer of 2024

ELIGIBILITY

Eligible students will:

- Be enrolled in college as first-years or sophomores in fall 2023
- Be interested in taking courses and conducting research in security studies
- Have a unique perspective on state power and/or security studies, based on their identity and/or personal experiences
